

# NATURAL PROTECTED AREAS CREATED BY INITIATIVE OR WITH THE COOPERATION OF ZÉ PEDRO DE OLIVEIRA COSTA

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*Ze Pedro has been a leading figure in the Brazilian Environmentalism in his performance along the years. He has played a decisive role in the creation of the Ministry of Environment, leading its Biodiversity agenda on several occasions, notably in the establishment of new protected areas which would represent all the Brazilian biomes, especially those in Amazonia, the Atlantic Forest and the Oceans. It was from that leading position that he also designed the same agenda for other Latin American countries. His tenure at Unesco and IUCN, in the latter as a Regional Counselor, enabled him to encourage the integration of continental efforts in favor of the Environment, which led to his engagement in the organization of the major Rio 92, Johannesburg and Rio+20 Conferences.*

*Largely, for his ability to establish a dialogue between the civil society and the government, and also with the Academia, he has become a major Brazilian and international reference in Sustainable Development, thus being an influential personality in the interaction among biodiversity, climate change and sustainability. As a host to the Brundtland Commission's Latin American meeting, held in São Paulo, Brazil, Zé Pedro triggered a new stage in Environmentalism from which we have benefited to date.*

*One of the greatest demonstrations of the success of his work is the unrelenting devotion to the protection of the Brazilian and Latin American biodiversity throughout the last fifty years. Since the first protected areas in the 1970's, whose creation is due to his efforts, he has specialized in seeking the protection of large areas that can also comprise ecological corridors. His experience as an architect and planner has contributed to a strategic territorial vision, approached from a broad perspective.*

*This distinguished characteristic has led the internationally renowned environmentalist Russel Mittermeyer to acknowledge that "Zé Pedro was the one who changed the scale of protection of the Brazilian protected areas." By this present table of areas created as a result of his proposition and/or collaboration with several environmentalists, one can see the result of this work, which comprises 180 new protected areas amassing a total of 159 million hectares.*

*It is, therefore, with great pride that, as a friend and also a collaborator, I introduce this publication which demonstrates that, with courage and determination, we can reach higher grounds towards achieving a better future for our planet.*

## ABOUT THE AUTHOR

José Pedro de Oliveira Costa, an architect and environmentalist, was born in Taubaté, São Paulo State, in 1945. He has a Master's degree in Environmental Planning by the University of California, Berkeley, USA and a PhD in Environmental Structures, with distinction, by the University of São Paulo, where he's been a professor since 1974.

He was the first São Paulo State's Secretary of Environment, President of São Paulo State's Environmental Council - CONSEMA, Coordinator of the Mata Atlântica Consortium, President of the National Council of the Atlantic Forest's Biosphere Reserve of the UNESCO-MAB System, and Coordinator of the Brazilian Committee of the MAB Program.

José Pedro had several mandates as the President of the National Council Environmental Council - CONSEMA. Additionally, he was the Ministry of Environment's Secretary of Biodiversity and Forests, a position he's presently holding for a second time.

He was the Special Counselor to the Director of UNESCO's World Heritage Center, in Paris, and for six years, he was Latin America's counselor and representative in the International Union Council for the Preservation of Nature - IUCN. He also coordinated the Environmental Program of the Latin American Institute and was the host of the South American meeting of the Brundtland Commission held in São Paulo.

Author of several books and articles published in Brazilian and foreign periodicals, he also wrote "AIURUOCA, Matutu e Pedra do Papagaio" [Aiuruoca, Matutu and Parrot Rock], a study about the preservation of the natural and cultural environment, published by EDUSP - University of São Paulo's Publisher.

As a consultant in environmental planning, he carried out several works in Brazil, Latin America, Europe and Africa. He was the proponent of several large-scale projects such as the ones for the Andes Corridor, the Biosphere Reserves of the Brazilian Atlantic Forest, the Cerrado, Pantanal, Amazonia and Caatinga biomes as well as the Atlantic Dorsal Mountain Chain. He took part or collaborated in the proposition for creating more than 150 new Brazilian protected areas, both terrestrial and marine, which add up to more than 159 million hectares, being the National Park of Tumuc-uaque in Amazonia worthy of notice for its four million hectares, the largest protected tropical forest area in the world.

For his work in defense of Mother Nature, Mr. Oliveira Costa has received from the Dutch Royal House the Golden Ark Commendation among several other awards.

Presently, at the Advanced Studies Institute of the University of São Paulo, he is the vicecoordinator of the Amazonia in Transformation Program and participates in the Primates Operation project, which aims at saving 35 species of these endangered animals.

He is a founding member of WWF Brazil, of SOS Pro Mata Atlântica Foundation, and of FUNATURA - Fundação Pro-Natureza.
